- > a full-time undergraduate student of HKSYU
- a responsible person with a sense of mission, positive values and attitudes
- having good collaboration and interpersonal skills
- honest, friendly, helpful, approachable, and proactive
- willing to treat others with respect and dignity
- passionate about the promotion of hall life and facilitation of personal growth

What do HAs do:

- Act as a channel of communication between residents and the Hall Management Unit (HMU), and foster better communication throughout the hall, especially for complaint and hall rules violation
- Have a close involvement in hall life, and organise & participate in hall functions
- > Enrich the hall life and enhance the experience of the residents
- > Attend periodic meetings and make contribution at the meeting
- ➤ Give advice to residents regarding their personal and social concern in hall life, and connect them with proper channels based on their needs and aspirations
- Be reasonably available and accessible by residents, spend adequate time in hall and interact regularly with the community
- Participate in a rotating duty schedule (not less than 5 nights per month) over the course of a semester, including University and public holidays; seek help from the security in the event of emergency.

Training

Subsidy

HA with satisfactory performance, development, and contribution will receive a subsidy equivalent to 50% of the standard room rate (capped at twin room rate). Such subsidy will be released at the end of the semester by cheque.

Application and Selection
