



As a Hall Ambassador (HA), you should be:

- > a full-time undergraduate student of HKSYU
- a responsible person with a sense of mission, positive values and attitudes
- having good collaboration and interpersonal skills
- honest, friendly, helpful, approachable, and proactive
- willing to treat others with respect and dianity
- passionate about the promotion of hall life and facilitation of personal growth

Roles and Duties

- Act as a **channel of communication** between residents and the Hall Management Unit (HMU), and foster better communication throughout the hall, especially for complaint and hall rules violation;
- Have a close involvement in hall life, and enhance the experience of the residents through organizing & participating in hall activities;
- Be reasonably available and accessible by residents, spend adequate time in hall and interact regularly with the community to enhance the bonding among residents;
- ➤ Give advice to residents regarding their personal and social concern in hall life, and connect them with proper channels based on their needs and aspirations so as to foster harmony in the halls of residence;
- Attend periodic meetings and make contribution at the meeting;
- Participate in a rotating duty schedule (not less than 3 nights per month) over the course of a semester, including University and public holidays; seek help from the security in the event of emergency.

Subsidy
